



Warli painting is a form of <u>tribal art</u> mostly created by the tribal people from the North <u>Sahyadri</u> Range in Maharashtra, India.

These rudimentary <u>wall paintings</u> use a set of basic geometric shapes: a circle, a triangle, and a square. These shapes are symbolic of different elements of nature. The circle and the triangle come from their observation of nature. The circle represents the sun and the moon, while the triangle depicts mountains and conical trees. In contrast, the square renders to be a human invention, indicating a sacred enclosure or a piece of land. Using the A3 sheet draw and colour one drawing based on Warli Painting.


